Required hours for graduation are 126 plus the credit hours from successful completion of RPED 250, 251 and all required ROTC courses.

**Students must take a two-course sequence of the same history: Western or World.
Thirty-three credit hours of coursework are required in one language at the 300- and 400- levels.

For all majors these required courses include 301 and 302; for Spanish, these also include SPAN 305.

Students who, through previous academic study or experience are deemed qualified may bypass Elementary (101-102) and/or Intermediate (201-202) courses in their chosen language, provided that They pass the next higher level course with a "C" or better. Bypassed courses will be included on the Citadel transcript as if they had been completed at The Citadel on a Pass/Fail basis. **PLEASE SEE NEXT PAGE**
