



1. An undergraduate student may choose to repeat a course in which he/she earned a grade of "C" or less. However, a student may not repeat a course which is taught at a lower level than or serves as a prerequisite for a course which the student has already completed.
2. The original course grade(s) will be replaced by the newer grade when calculating a student's Grade Point Ratio (GPR), quality hours and earned credit hours.
3. Both the old and new grades will appear on the student's transcript, but only the newer grade will be used in calculating the student's GPR.
4. Grade Replacement will be allowed on a maximum of **16** credit hours over the course of a student's undergraduate career.
