



Application for South Carolina Residency
GI Bill®/VA Benefits

(Please allow four to six weeks for processing)

According to SC Code of Laws Section 59-112-5(C), covered individuals who are enrolled at SC public institutions of higher education and receive education assistance under Chapter 30, Chapter 31, and Chapter 33, Title 38 of the U. S. Code are entitled to pay in-state tuition and fees without regard to the length of time the covered individual has resided in this State.

Covered individuals fall into the following categories:

- (1) A covered individual is an eligible veteran who is entitled to /receiving Chapter 30/31/33 GI Bill® benefits and residing within South Carolina while attending the state-supported institution
- (2) A covered individual is a person who is entitled to and receiving Chapter 33, Post 9/11 benefits due to their relationship to an eligible veteran*.
- (3) A person using transferred benefits under Section 3319, Title 38 of the United States Code while the transferor is on active duty in the Uniformed Service of the United States, their respective Reserve forces, or the National Guard.
- (4) A person who is entitled to and receiving rehabilitation benefits who lives in the state in which the institution is located (regardless of his/her formal State of residence).

**An eligible veteran has served ninety days or longer on active duty in the Uniformed Service of the United States, their respective Reserve forces, and the National Guard.*
